

European Championship Slingshot - 2025

General information

- Every European resident can participate in the European Championship '25.
- ♣ The 2025 European Championship is an indoor competition.
 All matches will be played at a 10-meter shooting distance.
- **♣** To participate in the European Championship, you must be registered no later than Friday 25 July 2025.

Pre-registrations no later than Sunday 13 July 2025 by transfer to bank account no. **BE67 1044 0669 5987 (biccode NICABEBB)** stating name, first name and nationality.

Please also complete an information sheet for each shooter, which can be found on the website.

Price: upon pre-registration; Adults ϵ 60. Youth (born in 2009 or later) ϵ 40 on site; Adults ϵ 70. Youth (born in 2009 or later) ϵ 50

- -This includes participation in all the competitions, and 3 meals.
- -Non-shooters can also participate in the meals for a contribution of:
 - €15 for the meal on Friday evening
 - €20 for the hot meal on Saturday evening
 - €15 for the meal on Sunday afternoon
- -A wristband obtained on the spot is valid as proof of participation to the meals.

WARNING!

Under no circumstances may a catapult be fired outside the facilities provided for this purpose, under penalty of exclusion.

Slingshots and ammunition.

- All types of slingshots may be used, only those with arm or wrist support are not allowed.
- A slingshot must always be used. So "Frameless" is not allowed.
- Round steel balls must be used as ammunition, maximum Ø10 mm.
 - Steel balls off 8 and 9.55 mm are offered on site.
 - Any other size must be provided by the shooter himself.
- Each shooter shows the ammunition to the referee before starting his turn.

The shooter places the necessary ammunition visible in the place provided for that purpose.

Under no circumstances may ammunition be taken from the trouser pocket or a bag once the starting signal has been given.

The shooters.

 At each competition, the shooter must go to the waiting area when called, while the shooters from the previous series are in the match zone.

This apply to all competitions.

The competitions.

On <u>Friday</u> the meeting match starts at 2.00 p.m. The points shot there will not be included in the results of the European Championship.

We shoot on different targets, namely

- moving target: the targets rotate from the right to the left.

10 attemps 5 points per hit (max 50 points)

- carboard target with 3 shooting targets

9 attemps 3 balls each target (max 90 punten) with multiple hits within the same disk, the highest result is lost! when hitting the line the highest score counts.

- golfballs :

5 attemps 5 points per hit (max 25 punten)

- Czech stand:

10 attemps 3 points per hit (max 30 punten)

Behind each shooter is a referee who will record each shot, and archived the score.

All points are added together, the winner is the one with the highest number of points after the 4 different tests.

They shoot 2 different tests after the other.

Time span: 3 minutes to complete the test,

2 minutes to leave the shooting place and to be manned by the shooters of the next series.

The time starts running irrevocably at the sound signal!

In case of equality of points, the cardboard targets are shot according to the Sudden Death system, only for the places 1, 2 and 3

'SUDDEN DEATH' on Friday

1 shot on the target circles on the top left, then te second and subsequent shooter take their run.

If another turn is needed, this is done on the circles on the top right.

If an third turn is needed, this is done on the bottom target circles.

In the evening a bread meal is offered, for which the competition may be stopped briefly to give everyone the opportunity to eat.

On <u>Saturday</u>

we start the day at 11.00 with a reception for all the participants, their supporters, sponsors and guests.

At 12.45 the district aldermen will show their kills with the catapult, and then,

at 13.00 the EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP INDIVIDUAL will start.

We shoot at WSA-stands and in timeblocks

Everyone shoots 2 series on the stands with targets of:

8 cm (2 points)

7 cm (4 points)

6 cm (6 points)

5 cm (8 points)

4 cm (10 points)

Total 30 points (x2)

Later, 2 series will follow on the WSA-stands with 5 discs of 4 cm.

Each group have 3 minutes and 5 attemps to hit the targetdiscs.

Every shooter is free to choose which disc he/she tries to hit

Every shot taken after the sound signal, is considered non shot.

In the next 2 minutes those who have shot, can leave de competition arena, and the next serie of shooters can line up.

The time has running irrevocably at the sound signal!

The winners are he of she who have collected the most points after 4 series.

In case of equality of points, the podiumplaces 1, 2 and 3 will be determinated by shooting according to the "Sudden Death" system.

Only those shooters with the 3 highest scores kan participate.

-SUDDEN DEATH-, on Saturday

Shooting is done by the WSA-stands, with discs size 4 cm. Each shooter delivers 1 shot in turn, until the place 1, 2 and 3 is known

In the evening, the competion is stopped for a meal, our famous Belgian fries, with a choice of 9 different types of meat, as much as you want.

On <u>Sunday</u> we start at 11.00 a.m. with the EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP COUNTRY TEAMS

Each country provided 4 names of the team that will defend their country, which may a mixed team, by Saturday evening at the latest. During the test, they cannot be replaced. A country team that does not have 4 representatives can supplement its with a shooter from another country. You only can participate in 1 team.

These matches gonna shot on the WSA-stands. 1 serie on these with the targets of different sizes, a 2nd serie with the discs with the size of 4 cm.

The points of the 4 team members are added together; the final total determines the ranking. In case of equality of points, the places 1, 2 and 3 will be determined by "Sussen Death"

-SUDDEN DEATH-

The 4cm targets gonna shot at.

Each country will have 1 shooter attempt, each country in turn.

A 2nd attempt, and further attemps will be taken by a different shooter from that country, until the podium places 1, 2 and 3 are known.

After that match, we will immediately move to the award ceremony for all the shot matches: the meeting match, the European Championship on Saturday and the European Championship for national teams on Sunday.

Afterwards, we sit down on the table to enjoy a meal; hot chicken with toppings and bread.

At around 14 p.m. those who still want to shoot can take part in our friendly COUPLES COMPETITION.

The couples for this are composed by using the ranking of the Saturday competition.

The winner of these get's the last as a co-mate.

The 2nd forms a team with the second last, and so on.

No account is taken of nationality, male or female, adult or youthshooter.

Shooting is done on the Belgian stands

Each shooter of the team shoots 1 shot in turn and has 7 attemps.

When all the targets have been hit, 30 points have allready noted. If there is still ammunation left, the discs are put back upright and shooting can continue.

If there is a equality of points for places 1, 2 and 3, a 2nd serie follows until the podium is composed.

As soon as the result is known, the trophies of this game will be awarded.

De trophies.

There are trophies for:

-Friday

places 1, 2 and 3 for 3 series: men, woman and youth.

- Saturday (European Championship):

places 1, 2 and 3 for 3 series: men, woman and youth.

-Sunday (European Championship National Teams)

places 1, 2 and 3: for each country a trophie and 4 medals.

-Sunday (competition for couples)

places 1, 2 en 3: 1 trophie for each team member.
